Christian Devotion on Thankfulness

Read: Luke 17: 11-19(NKJV)

We read here how Jesus healed ten men with leprosy. They cried out to Jesus as He was passing by. Jesus healed all ten, but only one returned and gave thanks to Jesus.

Like the other nine, do we forget to give thanks and praise to God when we receive answers to our prayers, or when He comes through in some miraculous way to provide for a particular need?

Sometimes we can take for granted what God does in our lives, but we must have the same attitude that this man had when he saw that he was clean. He didn't hesitate to give thanks to Jesus - but praised and worshiped Him. There is so much we can think of in our own lives to be thankful for. All we need to do is look around and see how God has blessed us. God has poured out His blessings in abundance. May we indeed have thankful hearts, and live in an attitude of thanksgiving every day.
