Christian Devotional on Forgiveness

## Read: Philemon 4-21 (NKJV)

This is a wonderful story of God's forgiveness and restoration and the need to forgive others who have wronged us. We all have times in our lives when we need to forgive and be forgiven. As long as we live in our human flesh, we will be hurt and hurt others—and sometimes we may not even realize we have hurt someone else.

I believe that forgiveness is the key to healing. It is the start point in the healing process. We can never know true inner peace until we have forgiven. I know it's not easy. We will sense a heavy burden being lifted from us, because not forgiving is a heavy load to bear.

If you feel you have an unforgiving spirit or hold resentment in your heart, will you give it up to the Lord today? He loves you and truly understands what you have been through. The start point to truly being free is to forgive.

Be gentle and forbearing with one another and, if one has a difference (a grievance or complaint) against another, readily pardoning each other; even as the Lord has [freely] forgiven you, so must you also [forgive]. – Colossians 3:13 (AMPC)
