Devotional: Getting Right With God

Children's Devotion on being right with God by living in God's light

Read: <u>1 John 1:5-10</u> (NKJV)

We read here that God is light and that there is no darkness in Him. Because of that, we who confess to be 'Christian' but are not living by the truth of the gospel, cannot be living in God's light–but still in darkness.

We cannot say we that have not sinned. Even as Christians, we can still stumble along the way. Nobody is perfect. We all make mistakes by what we say or do.
