Devotional: Our True Image–Part 1

Christian Women's Devotion on knowing we're fearfully & wonderfully made

Read: Psalm 139:13-16 (AMP)

...I will give thanks and praise to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well...(v.14)

God formed each of us in our mother's womb. Even there, He was moulding us and shaping us—creating a masterpiece. He created every part of us: from our facial features, hair colour, eye colour, skin colour to even our smile and laugh.
