## **Devotional: Resurrection Victory**

## Christian Devotion about the victory of Christ being ours

Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors and gain an overwhelming victory through Him who loved us [so much that He died for us]. - Romans 8:37 (AMP)

We live, here and now, in Christ's resurrection victory. This isn't just something we will experience when we die and are resurrected to eternal life. Resurrection victory is for now!
