## Christian Christmas Devotion Based on Mary's Song

## Read: Luke 1:46-55 (NKJV)

Mary was a well-chosen vessel who God used to be the Mother of Jesus. She had a humble, gentle and quiet spirit, and she accepted in humbleness the will of God for her life. She didn't regard herself or the difficulties and hardships she would have to endure by carrying the Messiah. She rejoiced! She felt honoured by God for Him to choose her, 'a lowly maid servant'.
