Christian Devotion about reflecting Jesus in our hearts

As in water face reflects face, So the heart of man reflects man. - Proverbs 27:19 (AMP)

Water is like a mirror. As we look into a pool of water, we see our reflection. So it is with a person's heart. Our heart is like a mirror; it reflects what we're truly like.
